- Assemblyman Sean Ryan's Proposed IDA Reform Bill

- Executive Director Bartlett reviewed a copy of a bill being proposed by Assemblyman Sean Ryan that would limit the ability of Town IDA's in Erie County to grant relief from taxes to a company to Town taxes only. We could only grant County, School and Village tax relief with the approval of each of these taxing jurisdictions. We would need this approval for each individual project we are considering.

We will be co-ordinating our efforts in opposition to this bill with the New York State Economic Development Council. Even though this bill aims at Erie County only it could have a ripple effect across the State. There is some question as far as if this bill is constitutional. We probably need legal advise. I also will be working with the Town Board and possibly the Village Boards to get their support in opposing this bill as an end run around the home rule planning powers of the NYS Constitution. This bill can also be interpreted as a way for the county to impose its will on municipalities that have committed to redevelopment through their master plans. As of this date I am not aware of a companion bill in the Senate.
